Principal’s Report:

Welcome to our new member Jay Slaughter.

- Carpool procedures: 500 cars during morning drop off. CPS staff is doing the best they can while under construction. Students are not counted tardy unless they arrive after 7:55. Teachers do not take attendance until announcements.
- Technology update: Almost 100%, smart boards are in. New intercom system is working. Panic buttons for teachers are coming soon.
- Administrative offices: Construction is on track.
- ASP: 413 students enrolled, 350 students stay every day. The new ASP director is Jennifer Matthews.
- CPS Enrollment: 950 enrolled, 158 at the Pre-k.
- Adopt a Classroom: All but 9 classrooms have been adopted. We are looking at possibly asking classrooms that have multiple donations to share with the 9 remaining rooms.
- Solar Eclipse: Monday, August 21st School will be delayed. Any letter sent in explaining that they are absent due to the solar eclipse will be excused. It will not count against perfect attendance. Students at school will watch the livestream.
