STUDENTS: You must know your AP Classroom username and password and the email address you gave for username/password recovery in the event you cannot remember this on the day of the exam. Make sure you are familiar with this information to expedite the login process on Exam days.

Students may arrive/leave campus based on exam times & are not required to stay at school once an exam is complete. For example, a morning AP exam student may leave once testing is over OR a student may report to campus at 11:45 on time for an afternoon exam. If a student feels the need to be in classes on the day of an exam before or after testing, that is their choice, but if not, the absence will be excused & will not be held against his/her exemption status.
