Old Business -

- Powderpuff April 2024 \$2604 (profit) 2023 \$3034 (profit)-Amy Dobbins: We made less profit because staff members were admitted for free and over-ordered pizza. The game also started earlier this year and may have affected attendance.
- Graduation May 2024 Report \$1717 solid profit Tucker: Used leftover water and drinks from Powderpuff: added chips and candy to the concession. We sold out of drinks, chips, and most candy. We need more food items in 2025.
- Fee Day July 2024 Report—Tonya Lutjens: More student fees were paid this year. Everyone who paid PTC dues and student fees was entered into a raffle (Turtle Box Speaker), and all volunteers were thanked. Senior fee day hours can be reduced to three. Combine Junior/sophomore day hours should be 4 hours minimum with more than six volunteers.
- Back to School Breakfast Report—Hospitality: It went well. We served Panera, a yogurt bar, and coffee/juice. Panera was donated. PTC spent approx \$250. We had teachers join PTC for a reduced price of \$5 for the first time.
