- 1. Upcoming Parent Meetings** – This year we will building upon our upcoming 9<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade student/parent registration meetings by adding upcoming 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students as well. We are thinking of doing the upcoming 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade meetings in the afternoons (3:30-7:30ish) over several days (3-4 days) in mid-March.
- 2. Second Semester Plan** – Dr. Kathryn Bradley will be returning to serve as an assistant administrator – She will begin on Feb. 1.
- 3. PBIS** – The committee has implemented this program across the campus. Dr. Feuerbach shared information concerning a program, *Changing Kids Hearts*. This program reportedly works well together with the PBIS program, strengthening students' connectedness to others through enhancing healthy bonds with their teachers and establishing collaborative agreements of acceptable behavior.
- 4. Check and Connect** - Teacher mentors for identified students. This process started in October and teacher mentors meet with their mentee weekly.
- 5. Proposed addition to classes:** AP Human Geography, Introduction to Law and Public Safety, Education Pathway, and a change in social studies sequencing:  
Beginning with next year's freshmen, they will take year-long World Geography or AP Human Geography. They will then take World History or AP World History (10<sup>th</sup> grade), U.S. History or APUSH (11<sup>th</sup> grade), half-credit of Economics/AP Economics with half-credit of Government/AP Government (12<sup>th</sup> grade).
